### Terms & Conditions

#### Overview

#### Terms & Conditions

These Terms and Conditions apply to the Santander Student Tech Prize Draw 2026 (referred to as the "prize draw"). By applying to the prize draw, applicants agree to be bound by the following Terms and Conditions:

1. The Provider is Santander UK plc, 2 Triton Square, Regent's Place, London, NW1 3AN, United Kingdom.
2. MacBook Air is a trademark of Apple Inc. This promotion is not conducted in association with or endorsed by Apple Inc.
3. To enter, you'll need to meet the following eligibility criteria:
  - a) You must be aged 18 or older and resident in the UK.
  - b) You must currently be registered and studying at any Further Education or Higher Education institution (during the 2025/2026 academic year) in the UK. You can also enter if you're doing a degree apprenticeship.
  - c) You must complete an entry form on Santander Open Academy which includes providing a valid student ID number and confirm which UK institution you attend.
4. You can enter the prize draw via Santander Open Academy any time from **09:00 (GMT) on 05/01/2026 until 23:00 (GMT) on 19/02/2026**. Santander reserves the right to close the prize draw early in exceptional circumstances (acting at its discretion).
5. Entries not submitted in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, or entries which are delayed, duplicated, incomplete, illegible, mislaid or lost through technical problems will be disqualified. No responsibility is accepted for such entries. Proof of submission online will not be accepted as proof of submission.
6. You can only enter the prize draw once.

Successful applicants will receive a confirmation email (informing them that they been awarded) from Santander Open Academy on 23/02/2026. **If you're chosen as a winner, you must accept the award within 7 days (by 02/03/2026).** You can do this by clicking on the link in the email. If, after 2 email attempts (with 24+ hours separation) and a phone call (if a number is provided), Santander cannot contact you, a new winner will be selected among the remaining applicants following the original process.
10. If successful, and once you've accepted the MacBook, Santander will share your details with JS Group (the third party managing the Santander Aspire webstore). This will be within 7 working days after the MacBook acceptance window closes on 02/03/2026. JS Group will create your account on the Santander Aspire webstore so that you can purchase your MacBook Air. We encourage you to review JS Group's privacy notice to understand how they'll store and process your personal data when you use the webstore.
11. Santander reserves the right to verify the student status of any winners in the prize draw. This may include requesting proof of enrolment or any other relevant documentation. Failure to provide sufficient proof of student status upon request will result in disqualification from the prize draw.
12. If successful and you're found not to be a student after verification, you'll be asked to return any prizes awarded. Additionally, any costs incurred by the company because of this non-compliance may also be recovered.
