

Santander Universities Brighter Futures Grants | Terms & Conditions

These Terms and Conditions apply to the Santander Universities Brighter Futures Grants (to be collectively referred to as the "grant"). By applying to the grant, applicants agree to be bound by the following Terms and Conditions.

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible, you must:

1. Be enrolled as a current student (part-time or full-time) in any year of your degree at one of the following UK universities:
 - a. Aston University
 - b. Bournemouth University
 - c. Cardiff University
 - d. Keele University
 - e. Kingston University London
 - f. Oxford Brookes University
 - g. University of Birmingham
 - h. University of Brighton
 - i. University of Chester
 - j. University of Reading
 - k. University of Sheffield
 - l. University of Southampton
 - m. University of the West of England
 - n. University of Westminster
2. Know your student ID number and provide it via the application form
3. Check the specific requirements for your university and meet any additional criteria as mentioned on the landing page
4. Create an account on the Santander Scholarship Platform (if you are not registered already)

Terms and conditions for the grant

1. All applications must be submitted via the Santander Scholarship Platform from 01/03/2023 until 23:00 (GMT) 30/04/2023.
2. Upon submitting your application, you must accept the terms and conditions for the grant.
3. You can only apply to the grant once (one application per student).
4. Applications not submitted in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, or applications which are delayed, duplicated, incomplete, illegible, mislaid or lost through technical problems will be disqualified. No responsibility is accepted for such entries.
5. Winners will be selected at random (using an online random generator) by their respective university from all valid submissions received. If you wish to find out more about this process, please contact your university. The university's decision on the allocation of the award, in accordance with these terms and conditions, is final. There is no appeal process.
6. It is your responsibility to ensure you read and understand the eligibility criteria and submit your application appropriately, on time and following the application requirements as indicated on the Santander Scholarship Platform.
7. If you are selected as a winner, you must accept the grant within 14 days of 12/05/2023. You can do this by clicking on the link in the successful email sent by the Santander Scholarship Platform. Failure to do this will result in the grant being reassigned to another student from your university.
8. Once you have accepted the grant, you can expect to hear directly from your university to confirm the grant payment process.

Key Dates and Selection Process

1. Application process

- You must first register on the Santander Scholarship Platform in order to apply for the grant. Applications are open from 01/03/2023 and will close at 23:00 (GMT) on 30/04/2023.
- Please ensure that you read the Terms and Conditions before applying.
- You will receive confirmation of your application submission from the Santander Scholarship Platform.

2. Selection process

- Once applications have closed, each university will select 10 winners (from their own institution) at random. This will be done using an online random-selection platform.

3. Winners announced

- You will be told the outcome of your application on 12/05/2023 via an email from the Santander Scholarship Platform.

4. Receipt of the grants

- If you are a winner, you must accept the grant within 14 days of 12/05/2023. You can do this by clicking on the link in the successful email sent by the Santander Scholarship Platform. Failure to do this will result in the grant being reassigned to another student from your university.
- Once the grant has been accepted, you can expect to hear directly from your university to confirm the grant payment process.
