University

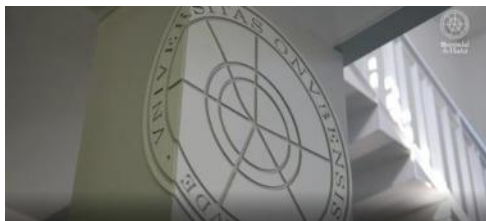
The University of Huelva is young and dynamic, with a large library, sports facilities, university canteen with affordable prices and an extensive timetable.

Classes

From 26 June to 21 July.
3 hours of classes per day.
A total of 60 hours (8 ECTS).
15 hours per week programme.

Intermediate to Advanced Spanish Language Intensive Course



What is it about?

This course is especially designed for students with some knowledge of Spanish (intermediate and advanced levels).

When and where is it?

At the University of Huelva in the southwest of Spain. Classes take place in El Carmen Campus.

The 2023 face-to-face edition will take place from 26th of June to 21st of July (registration opens 20th of March and ends 7th of May)

Who is it for?

The Summer School is designed for international students having a Spanish level from B1.

What is it for?

To prepare students to master Spanish up to B2/C1 level.

To offer international students a language training in Spanish as a Foreign Language aiming to gain cultural knowledge.

What is in the programme?

- 60 hours of Spanish language teaching (8 ECTS).
- A weekly cultural activity which is designed to go beyond the language immersion itself.

Students take a placement test to be placed in the most appropriate group according to level. The maximum group size is 10 students per class.

Outside the classroom, students can participate in organised activities designed to help enhance language skills through immersion in Spanish culture.

Where to stay?

Huelva offers a wide arrange of ho(s)tels, touristic apartments and shared accommodation in students' flats.

Where to eat?

The canteen is situated on El Carmen Campus, where the classes take place. It provides a daily menu at a competitive price and a wide array of traditional plates.

How much does it cost?

The course costs €450* plus an administrative non-refundable fee of €75

- The fee does not include accommodation or meals.
- Cultural activities and material are included.

* Remember that you can apply for a Santander Scholarship covering tuition fees - €450-
