



7th Poster Contest

8th Postgraduate Studies Week

The management teams at the Centre for Postgraduate Studies (CEP) and the UIB Doctoral School, in partnership with Santander Universities, are pleased to announce that the 7th Poster Contest for UIB master's and PhD students will take place during the 8th Postgraduate Studies Week (2nd-5th May 2023).

UIB master's students who were enrolled on an official master's programme in the 2021-22 academic year may enter the master's category (as long as they did not win the previous edition), as well as those who are enrolled for the 2022-23 academic year. Students who are enrolled on a PhD programme for the 2022-23 academic year may enter the PhD category.

There will be ten prizes worth 150 euro each, five for the master's category and five for the PhD category, one for each area of knowledge: Arts and Humanities, Science, Health Sciences, Social and Legal Sciences, and Engineering and Architecture.

Contest Terms and Conditions

1. Registration

Those who wish to take part in the contest must sign up to the Santander website http://app.becas-santander.com/program/becas-santander-estudios-vii-concurs-de-posters-2023> and submit their proposed poster in electronic format (.pdf and .jpg) via the form on the following website: setmanadelpostgrau.uib.cat>. The deadline is 16th April 2023.

Participants may only enter one category: the master's poster contest or PhD poster contest.

2. Exhibition





Selected posters will be displayed on the following website for the week of **2nd-5th May**: <<u>setmanadelpostgrau.uib.cat</u>>.

3. Voting

Voting will take place over the UIB portal and be open to the entire university community. Each voter may select three posters in the master's category and three in the PhD category. Votes may only be cast once.

The ten winning posters will be those voted for by the university community.

4. Prizes

The prize pot for each category is worth 750 euro: 150 for each winning poster, five in the master's category and five in the PhD category.

The prizes will be handed out on Friday 5th May.





Appendix 1. POSTER DESIGN

Posters must be understandable for all participants from other areas of knowledge and have the following features:

- 1. Size: A0 (841 x 1189 mm). They must be submitted in .pdf or .jpg format and be vertical designs.
- 2. Structure:
 - Logo: the UIB logo must be included. It can be downloaded from the following website:
 https://logo.uib.cat/descarregues>
 - Title: short and understandable
 - Author(s). If the work is by more than one author, the student must come first. The other author(s) should then follow alongside their affiliation (department or, where applicable, research centre)
 - The master's or PhD thesis tutors and supervisor(s) must be included
 - Abstract: a summary of the work
 - Objectives: general and specific objectives that may be formulated independently or as part of the abstract
 - Research development: the main research development stages
 - Results (obtained and/or planned)
 - Sustainable Development Goal(s) (SDG) that link to the work undertaken (between one and three). For more information, please see: https://www.un.org/sustainabledevelopment/es/objetivos-de-desarrollo-sostenible/
 - Conclusions

- 1. Avoid including too much information
- 2. Use diagrams, graphics, figures, photos, etc.
- 3. Use a relatively large font size
- 4. Use colours to differentiate sections and highlight the most important information.
