Terms and Conditions



Successful recipients are subject to several conditions, detailed below.

To be eligible you must:

- Be enrolled as a Bangor University student (undergraduate, postgraduate, PhD) OR
- Be a recent Bangor University graduate of no longer than 12 months
- You must know your Student ID number and provide it via the application form
- Create an account on the Santander Open Academy platform, confirming that you meet the eligibility criteria. Direct applications (e.g. submitted via email) will not be accepted
- Submit your application on the Santander Open Academy platform by clicking the enrol button.

The application will only take a few minutes to complete. Upon applying to the opportunity, students accept the respective terms and conditions.

Timeline and Key dates

- Applications are open from **Wednesday 1st May until Friday 31st May 2024.**

Selection Process

- Successful candidates will be selected randomly, on the basis that they have met all the eligibility and application criteria, and will be contacted via email from the Santander open Academy platform.
- Candidates must accept the offer within 10 days of receiving their successful email via the Santander Open Academy Platform. Failure to do this will result in the award being reassigned to another applicant.
- The University's decision on the allocation of the award in accordance with these terms and conditions is final. There is no appeal process.

Recipient Obligations

- If, by reason of any emergency or other circumstance, the Recipient is unable to complete the training / experience, they will be required to refund all or part of the Fund amount as may be considered reasonable in all the circumstances.

- Recipients may be publicised on the University website and in the media; recipients will be expected to provide appropriate feedback (reports, blogs, pictures and/or videos) to support this.
- Recipients are required to provide photographic proof (where appropriate) within 4 weeks of completing the training / experience.
- Recipients may be interviewed by the press office and/or be invited to attend events with donors who support the fund, partners in the project, other successful recipients and the wider University community, allowing discussion about the projects that have been carried out.
