

# Santander Universities £100k Prize Draw (Autumn 2024) Terms & Conditions

#### Overview

At Santander, we want to connect as many students as possible with the resources they need to make the most of their studies. Santander Universities are giving 400 undergraduates and post-graduates – from all UK universities - a Santander grant worth £250 to support their studies. Successful applicants will be able to use the grant as credit to buy a variety of resources directly from the <u>Santander Aspire webstore</u> (owned and managed by JS Group) or withdraw as cash to fund their university studies and needs.

Before entering the prize draw, please read through the following Terms and Conditions and make sure you meet all the criteria listed below.

#### **Terms & Conditions**

These Terms and Conditions apply to the Santander Universities £100k Prize Draw (collectively referred to as the "grant"). By applying to the prize draw, you agree to be bound by the following Terms and Conditions:

- 1. The Grantor is Santander Universities UK (a division of Santander UK plc, 2 Triton Square, Regent's Place, London, NW1 3AN, United Kingdom).
- 2. To enter, you'll need to meet the following eligibility criteria:
  - a. You must currently be studying an undergraduate or postgraduate degree during the 2024/2025 academic year at any UK university. You can also enter if you're doing a degree apprenticeship.
  - b. You must be a UK resident.
  - c. You must be able to provide a valid university student ID number.
  - d. You must confirm which UK university you attend.
- 3. You can enter the prize draw via the Santander Open Academy platform any time from 09:00 (GMT) on 01/10/2024 until 23:00 (GMT) on 28/11/2024. Santander Universities reserves the right to close the prize draw early in exceptional circumstances (acting at its discretion).
- 4. Entries that doesn't meet these Terms and Conditions, or entries which are delayed, duplicated, incomplete, illegible, mislaid or lost through technical problems will be disqualified. No responsibility is accepted for such entries. Proof of submission online will not be accepted as proof of submission.
- 5. You can only enter the prize draw once.
- 6. It is your responsibility to ensure you read and understand the eligibility criteria and submit your entry appropriately, on time and following the entry instructions/requirements indicated on Santander Open Academy.
- 7. Santander Universities will select 400 winners at random using an online random-selection platform. If you want to find out more about this process, please contact <a href="mailto:santander.universities@santander.co.uk">santander.universities@santander.co.uk</a>.
- 8. If successful, you'll receive an email directly from the Santander Open Academy platform on 03/12/2024 which confirms that you've been selected as a winner. Upon receiving this, you must accept the grant before 17:00 (GMT) on 10/12/2024. You can do this by clicking on the link in the email. You can also accept directly by logging into the Santander Open Academy platform and viewing 'My Applications'. If, after 2 email attempts with at least 24 hours separation between them and a phone call (if a valid phone number is provided), Santander Universities decides that it is not possible to get in touch with you to confirm acceptance of the grant, a new winner will be selected among the remaining applicants following the original process.
- 9. If successful, and once you've accepted the grant, Santander Universities will share your details with JS Group, the third party managing the Santander Aspire webstore by 18/12/2024. JS Group will create your account on the Santander Aspire webstore so that you can access your £250 grant. Successful applicants will receive 2 emails from JS Group: one which will include a link to the Santander Aspire webstore, including log-in details, and another which will confirm the grant value. We encourage you to review JS Group's privacy notice to understand how they'll store and process your personal data when you use the webstore.
- 10. Once you log in, you will be able to browse the Santander Aspire webstore where you'll be able to buy a variety of products/services using the £250 grant as part or full payment. Alternatively, you will be able to withdraw the grant as cash into your bank account. JS Group will provide a step-by-step guide on how to do this once you log into your webstore account. The value of the grant will automatically be credited to your JS Group user account.



- 11. Santander Universities reserve the right to verify the student status of any winners in the prize draw. This may include requesting proof of enrolment or any other relevant documentation. Failure to provide sufficient proof of student status upon request will result in disqualification from the prize draw.
- 12. If successful and you are found not to be a student after verification, you will be asked to return any prizes awarded. Additionally, any costs incurred by the company because of this non-compliance may also be recovered.
- 13. The credit which is applied to successful applicants' accounts will be valid for 12 months. This will start from the date when you receive your log-in details from JS Group. The credit applied to your account will be removed after the 12-month period.
- 14. The winners' surname and county will be available on request after 03/12/2024 for 30 days, subject to the winners' consent. The winners' information and winning entries (if applicable) must be provided to the Advertising Standards Authority on request in the event of a dispute.
- 15. If successful, you may be invited by Santander Universities or by your university (if you attend one of our partner universities) to provide a testimonial or case study. We will not publish a testimonial or case study without your permission.
- 16. If you are identified as a winner and you attend a partner university, the Grantor will inform your university of your success.
- 17. If requested by a partner university, and if you have provided consent, Santander Universities will inform your university of your entry into the prize draw.

### **General terms**

- 1. Santander Universities reserves the right to withdraw any entry to the prize draw that is found to be in breach of any of the pre-established conditions and/or rules laid out in the Term and Conditions.
- 2. Santander Universities reserves the right to update or amend these Terms and Conditions or foreclose the prize draw without prior notice at any time.
- 3. Santander Universities reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual that corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of this prize draw.
- 4. The prize draw and these Terms and Conditions are governed by English law and any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England.
- 5. To the fullest extent permitted by law and excluding death or permanent injury caused as a result of Santander Universities' negligence, Santander Universities accepts no liability for loss or injury as a result of the prize draw or receipt or misuse of any prize fund.
- 6. No cash or other alternatives to the grant will be offered.
