

Santander NCL Internships Scheme Summer 2025

Summary

Newcastle University Careers Service in partnership with Santander Universities are offering 15 funded internships to Newcastle University students.

Newcastle University are facilitating 15 funded internships with SMEs and/or charities. These internships are for a minimum of 100 hours. The bursary amount is dependent on the duration of the internship, the student will receive Santander funding of £1000 towards their bursary.

Requirements

These internships are only available to current Newcastle University students, including Newcastle University students graduating in 2025.

Students please note: All Newcastle University students can apply but priority will be given to those graduating in 2025.

General Information

Newcastle University students have the opportunity to secure a graduate level internship with an SME or charity via the Careers Service and funded by Santander Universities. Please note, only current Newcastle University students are eligible to apply and you must be registered on a 2024-25 course of study.

An internship will allow you to develop your employability skills and gain experience in the sector of your choice.

The internship will take place during the summer 2025 vacation.

Duration – minimum of 100 hours

Students will receive a Santander subsidised bursary of £1000.

Application and Selection Process

NCL Internships are advertised on My Career. You will apply via a short application form and attach your CV, shortlisted candidates will then be invited to interview with the employer.

Students should demonstrate why they feel they are suitable by referencing the skills, knowledge and experience required in the advert and express why they are interested in the company, role and sector.
