

Information on the course “Treasure Hunting” at Technische Universität Berlin

Treasure Hunting is a 12 ECTS course.

Who can apply?

- Every Master student of TU, HU, FU Berlin and Charité from their third semester of Master study can apply for this course – no matter their study background, age, gender, etc.
- Interdisciplinarity and diversity are very welcome to sparkle the innovation potential of the group!

What is the schedule?

- You have to complete the whole module „Treasure Hunting“ in one semester: 2 weeks of summer school on campus with additional work at home. Summer school takes place at TU Berlin from 22nd July until 2nd of August (except the weekend) from 10:00-18:00.

Application Deadline:

- from 1.4.2024 to 1.5.2024

Language of teaching:

- English (if you have a group with German Native Speakers only, you can also speak German in your group work).

Application Documents:

- Every applicant has to use their university e-mail address to register at the Santander Scholarship Platform and fill in the required information (full name, gender, nationality, etc.).
- Required documents to be uploaded are: Enrollment Certificate of the current Master course showing the current semester or starting date of the Master study
