Students are required to notify CETYS in advance if they require additional documents.



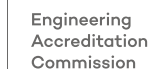

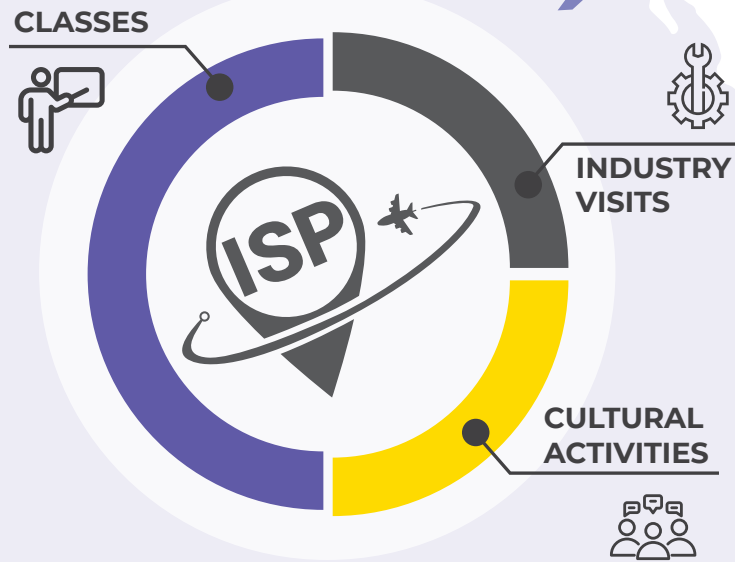
